# FOOD & BARS AT CITY HALL

## There are four stage venues in the Newcastle City Hall:-

1. Banquet Room (Ground Floor)  
– Bar, Meals, Dance Floor
2. Concert Hall (1st Floor behind reception desk)  
– Dance Floor
3. Cummings Room (1st Floor)  
– Bar, Carpet, Dance Area
4. Hunter Room (2nd Floor)  
– Bar, Carpet, Dance Area.

All rooms are accessible via the elevator if you don't want to use the stairs. To assist people with mobility issues, access to the City Hall can be organised via Wheeler Place. Please phone 0411 752 539 to gain access.

## TRANSPORT & PARKING

There are several parking options surrounding Newcastle City Hall. (Details at festival enquiry desk).

- **The Argyle Street Parking Station**, which provides Friday all day parking for \$19 but after 4pm until 4am the cost is then just \$3. All day parking on Saturday and Sunday is \$9 each day. This car park is only a short walk across Hunter Street and then up Wheeler Place to the City Hall.
- **Hunter Parking and Storage**, located at Gibson Street is a 5 min walk to the City Hall but is not as economical as the one in Argyle Street.
- **Wilson Parking Station at Interchange** offer affordable and secure parking at The Store Newcastle Car Park, located at 854 Hunter St in the heart of Newcastle CBD.
- **Secure Parking - 348 King St, Newcastle** one block from the City Hall - all day parking \$12.
- There is also street parking and metered parking surrounding Newcastle City Hall. Free parking after 5pm on Friday. Saturday and Sunday—check parking signs—most parking meter charges cease at 12 Noon on Saturday and do not apply on Sundays.
- In Burwood Street a short distance from the City Hall there are a number of disabled parking places plus a loading zone which is free after 12 Noon Saturday.

## TAXI SERVICE:

Newcastle Taxis: 13 22 27, Silver Service Taxi: 133 100, Newcastle Hire Cars: 4960 1800.

There is a pickup/set down point just in front of the Kingsley Hotel adjacent to the City Hall and a Taxi Rank in Hunter Street opposite Wheeler Place (Old Civic Station—now Tourism Centre).
