Change of Venue for Our Monthly Concerts

In the last week of April, the Jazz Club Committee was informed that the Central Leagues Club was going to turn the back of their function room into a billiard area. Two billiard tables will be installed.

It was clear that the reduced space would be too small to accommodate the jazz club audience. It was then necessary to find at short notice, a new venue with suitable facilities including a dance floor. Souths Leagues Club at Merewether were keen to assist us, but they had a prior booking for the last Sunday in May.

Consequently, we have booked the Wallsend Diggers Club for the May gig with Fish Fry with the rest of the gigs for 2023 to be held at Souths Merewether. The first gig at Souths will be on Sunday 25 June with the popular 'Chasing the Moon'. It was not easy to find another venue at short notice particularly as some clubs such as Club Charlestown have also reduced the area they have available for live music.

We hope that all members will give us their support and attend the jazz club functions at Wallsend Diggers in May and then at Souths, Merewether.

Vale Jack McLaughlin



Jack McLaughlin passed away on Thursday 5 May. He was well known to jazz fans not only in Newcastle but throughout Australia as he was a regular participant in the yearly Australian Jazz Convention. Jack is pictured with his e flat clarinet which accompanied him on his many visits to New Orleans.

Jack was keen to promote jazz to young musicians. The photo below is a good example. It was taken at the Merimbula Jazz festival in 2019. Pictured 1-r David Saxon, Max Goeldner, Rachel Hamilton, Will Goeldner, Craig Goeldner, Ella Saxon, Tom Tyler, and Jack Mc Laughlin. David, Rachel, and Craig played with Jack when they first started in jazz. At Merimbula and at the Newcastle Jazz festival, David's daughter, Ella and Rachel and Craig's sons Max and Will played and sang in a band called 'The Smoothie Kings'.

In recent years Jack led the Frenchman Street Jazz Band at the Carrington Place Hotel and later at Earps Distillery. In 1974 Jack was pictured leading the Newcastle New Orleans Band at the Star Hotel, Newcastle (Col Hanson on piano). A 'Jack McLaughlin Memorial Band' will play at the Newcastle Jazz Festival on Saturday morning, 26 August.

Here are some of the bands/performers.



Bruce Mathiske, master guitarist, will be appearing at the festival on Sunday 27 August. Bruce is donating his time to support the festival where he once had his first gig — an event he remembers with great affection.

The Blues Point Vocal Group will be appearing on Saturday afternoon. This group mixes jazz vocal harmony with a walking bass and loads of humour! Blues Point vocal group are Lorraine Silk, Lauren Dawes, George Washingmachine, Dan Barnett, and Craig Scott (one of Australia's finest bass players). The repertoire ranges from jazz standards by Irving Berlin and Gershwin through to the hits of Ray Charles, Stevie

Wonder, Joe Cocker, Queen, and Adele that have been arranged specially for the group by some of Australia's top arrangers, Judy Bailey, Julian Lee, George Brodbeck and Bill Risby.







Nicki Parrot Quartet - Saturday 26 August

Nicki Parrott was born in Newcastle and started her musical training at four with the piano before switching to double bass when she was 15.

Nicki moved to New York in May 1994 and in June 2000 began performing with the legendary guitarist Les Paul. Nicki has performed in several Broadway shows. In 2007 & 2008 she received back-to-back honours for Swing Journal's Best Jazz Vocal Album with Moon River and Fly Me to The Moon, respectively.

At the Newcastle Jazz festival Nicki will be joined by Peter Locke on Piano, Andrew Dickeson on Drums, and the talented Tessie Overmyer on Saxophone.

Steve Brien

Steve Brien- From Bebop to Broadway- Saturday 26 August

An acclaimed jazz guitarist, Steve Brien established himself in the Sydney jazz scene in the late 1970s, playing with local jazz musicians such as Dale Barlow, James Morrison, and Don Burrows. In 1985 he won an overseas study grant and went to New York City. He returned to Australia in 1987 and toured with the James Morrison Quintet, travelling extensively through Australasia and Europe. In 1992 Brien returned to the US, establishing himself on the Connecticut jazz scene He returned to Australia in 1998 to join the Faculty of Music, lecturing in guitar, the Sydney Conservatorium. He now lives in Tasmania.
