
FROM VICE-PRESIDENT SHERIDEN




Vale Helen Ward and Nancy Minton

- Parking at the Newcastle Jazz Festival: The Argyle Street Parking Station which provides Friday all day parking for \$19 but after 4pm until 4am the cost is then just \$3. All day parking on Saturday and Sunday is \$9 each day. This car park is only a short walk across Hunter Street and then up Wheeler Place to the City Hall
- Hunter Parking and Storage, located at Gibson Street is a 5-minute walk to the City Hall but is not as economical as the one in Argyle Street
- Secure Parking- 348 King Street Newcastle- just one block from the City Hall- All day parking \$12.
- There is also street parking and metered parking surrounding Newcastle City Hall. Free parking after 5pm on Friday. Saturday and Sunday- check parking signs - most parking meter charges cease at 12 Noon on Saturday and do not apply on Sundays.
- In Burwood Street a short distance from the City Hall there are a number of disabled parking places plus a loading zone which is free after 12 Noon
